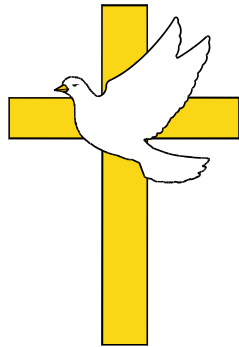

From the Pastor's Computer:

I would like to share an update with you on the two offerings that Salem sent to the 2018 Southwestern Texas Synod Assembly. Our Lenten Offerings were designated to the main Assembly offering which was going to the ELCA Fund for Leaders. It was announced that the North Texas/ North Louisiana Synod had given a little over \$25,000 at their assembly a week earlier. Salem gave a total of \$2,399.61 to this offering. Our assembly total was \$69,255.23. Quite impressive and very important for the training of our future leaders.

The second offering was the Tiemann Endowment Fund for Leadership Development, which will generate scholarships for lay and clergy from within our synod. The goal was \$39,000 and the assembly offering raised the total in the fund to \$57,170.23 which is a bold statement of the appreciation within the synod for the 18 years that Bishop Ray was our Bishop.

I am proud and celebrate our giving to specific causes that catch our interest and at the same time I am concerned with lack of consistent support of Salem's ongoing ministry through our regular offerings. Our giving dropped once again in May and we will find ourselves in the hole once our bills are paid. I will be sharing some of my thoughts about stewardship in the coming months.

Treasurers Report – We are \$300+ in the black! Yeah

Pastor's Report – Progress has been made in fixing the sound system. Equalizer was removed and the buzzing was stopped. Still having some trouble with some of the microphone wires, but, planning on working on it again in the very near future. We need to find someone to take over IT duties at the church. It would be preferred to have someone take over technical issues and someone to take over creative issues. Finally, we need to have acolyte training and confirmation training. Women's retreat in June.

Property Report – We have currently received 3 bids for lawn care and are also trying to develop a mowing schedule for members. They are all still in review and a decision has not been made. The custodial services contract was written earlier this month. Retha passed out the new contract to council members and Pastor Dan made a motion to approve the new contract and Cathy 2nd all voted to approve. Iron fencing has been ordered for the front of the church and is being generously donated. Electrician has finished installing new breakers in the sanctuary and he is redoing the legend on the breaker box.

The light above the pulpit have been fixed. We have received a bid for the roof in the office building. We are removing the skylights. Pastor Dan made a motion to spend the extra \$250 for the 30 year shingles and it was 2nd by Lindy. All members approved. The council also decided to not file any disputes with the wind storm insurance company. Retha is also putting together a list of approved vendors for the church. Finally, the playground should be in place soon!

Old Business – congregational meeting coming up soon for Endowment Fund Status. Also, Castle construction has ordered new doors and we are ordering new locks with new door handles.

New Business – Senior Sending is ready to go! Endowment Fund meeting is scheduled for June 10th.
