Reports:

Treasurer- We are not in a good situation. Currently, \$7,084 in the hole. Going forward, there will be a breakdown of designated offerings.

Pastors Report – Trained all of the kids who want to be acolytes.

There were a few more who came forward after the initial training who will be trained soon. Gathering a list of kids for confirmation class. Past Dan has also spoke with a few families looking to join our church

Proclaim – Currently looking for someone to do the acolyte scheduling because Linda has resigned.

Nurture – Sunday school has resumed after the summer break. Jenny and Dottie lead the family study and it is going well. They are using the SPARK Bible. Kids took turns reading. Katie and Lori will also lead the group. Currently looking for ways to include the kids in the worship service. Possibility of putting an insert in the pews for the parents. Pastor Dan wanted everyone to know that children are a good sign of a growing church! The council also discussed a possible children's section during worship service. We will look into haw the Lutheran church in Shiner Texas does their service.

Response - None

Property – Simple Maintenance Team (SMT) – The SMT met on Thursday, August 9th to walk through the work that the team will be doing each month. The team was able to perform most of the tasks, and get a better idea of the scope. A full job description, checklist and schedule is being prepared.

Education Building – Work has begun to clean out the rooms on the east/west hallway being used for storage. One of the rooms will be used by the SMT for their supplies and addition maintenance items. The large room on the southwest corner has been cleaned out, repainted and prepped for use by Upbring (Lutheran Social Services).

Lighting – The dusk-to-dawn lighting for the courtyard has been completed. EXIT signs and emergency lighting in both the education building and sanctuary will be tackled next.

Harvey Repairs – Castle Construction has completed their portion of repairs. Work still needs to be done in the Fellowship Hall kitchen and hall; congregation members will be taking care of that. The office roof is scheduled to be replaced.

Old Business – New filters in the sanctuary made the service a lot colder (we now have a schedule to change filters more regularly). All thermostats will eventually be replaced with programmable ones that should really help with our energy usage.

New Business – New lease agreement was approved for the Hurricane Harvey Relief organization. They will be paying \$1000/month to lease part of our Sunday school building. Pastor Dan 1st Lindy 2nd

Pastor Dan on vacation September 15-19 (Debbie's Mom turned "85") Pastor Dan to attend Arneckeville 150th celebration on October 7th. Steve Bales will preach in his absence.


